We are very enthusiastic about our future work in Madagascar. It is our passion to tell the good news of Jesus Christ to those who have never heard; to give them the chance to believe and be

lives - a country - transformed. AIM Madagscar strives to see this transformation.

We will be living in the capital, Antananarivo



(Tana for short). There we will start our language and culture study to be able to communicate the gospel in the heart language of the people. While there, we shall be part of the Tana FOCUS team. This team trains Malagasy Christians as missionaries to the unreached of Madagascar and beyond.

AIM seeks to see Christ-centered churches amongst all African peoples. As part of that commitment, AIM Madagascar is surveying the island for unreached or barely reached people groups and the possibilities to serve them. We shall be assisting in that work and will travel to various locations. In time, we hope to be involved in starting a new team amongst one of these groups.

As a family we have worked towards being missionaries for years, during which time Jurgen has studied Theology and Katja has started home educating the children.



AM's Vision

Africa is a huge continent – in fact it's bigger than China, the USA, Western Europe, India, Argentina and the UK.... combined! There are over 50 different countries in Africa; 1 billion people; 1000 indigenous languages; 950 people groups who've never heard the gospel, which of course presents a huge challenge!
